

Attachment III.E1-F14e Information clause - personal data of business partner

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA OF BUSINESS PARTNER

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC ("GDPR"), the Controller informs that:

- 1) MGGP S.A., with its registered office in Tarnów, address: ul. Kaczkowskiego 6, 33-100 Tarnów, entered into the National Court Register (KRS) by the District Court in Tarnów, 5th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under the following KRS number: 0000042514 (hereinafter referred to as the "Employer" or "Controller"), is the Controller of your personal data. Contact with the Controller is possible by email: odo@mggp.com.pl, by phone: +48 (14) 626 38 90 or in any other way chosen by you, including orally or in writing to the Controller's address.
- 2) Your personal data shall be processed for the purposes of:
 - taking actions aimed at the conclusion and performance of the agreement concluded with the Data Controller - on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) of GDPR and also your consent in the scope of personal data which were provided by you voluntarily during the conclusion and performance of the agreement (Article 6(1)(a) of GDPR);
 - performance by the Data Controller of legal obligations related to the concluded agreement (among others: keeping accounting books and tax returns) - on the basis of Article 6(1)(c) of GDPR in connection with applicable provisions of law which imply the necessity of fulfilling those obligations by the Data Controller, in particular the Tax Ordinance Act, the Goods and Services Tax Act and the Accounting Act;
 - communication, including responding to the questions asked, due to the legitimate interest of the Data Controller - in case of carrying out correspondence in traditional and electronic form with the use of email and contact form - on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) of GDPR;
 - pursuit of legitimate interests by the Controller, which, according to the Controller, are in particular: the exercise and defence of claims, ensuring the security of IT environment, application of internal control system;
 - if you have given your consent to the receipt of a newsletter and marketing communication, your data may be used for marketing purposes in relation to the services provided by the controller - on the basis of Article 6(1)(a) of GDPR.
- 3) Recipients of your personal data may be external entities providing services to the Data Controller, such as legal, audit, IT, postal or courier services, as well as entities to which the Controller makes personal data available, in accordance with applicable provisions of law, such as public institutions, including in particular the Tax Authority.
- 4) Your personal data shall be stored for the period until the date of conclusion of the agreement, or withdrawal from the conclusion of the agreement, or for the duration of the agreement, if the parties have concluded an agreement. Notwithstanding the above, some data may be processed for as long as possible, or as required under applicable provisions of law. After the expiry of the processing period, your personal data shall be permanently erased or anonymised.
- 5) Your personal data shall not be transferred to third countries or international organisations.
- 6) You have the right of access to the content of your data and the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing and the right to data portability.
- 7) To the extent that the processing of your personal data is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of your consent before its withdrawal.
- 8) You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data.
- 9) You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, address: ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw, +48 22 531 03 00, fax. +48 22 531 03 01, <https://uodo.gov.pl/pl/p/kontakt>; if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of GDPR or other applicable provisions of law regarding the processing of personal data.
- 10) The provision of personal data is voluntary, but necessary to conclude and perform the Agreement.
- 11) Your personal data are not subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
